Working Spirit and RSLWA proudly launched the Transition Employment Portal (TEP) for families in September 2024. This innovative platform is designed to empower veteran families by connecting them with tailored employment opportunities, offering a seamless transition into the workforce for spouses, partners, and children aged 15 - 17 year old, and 18 and above.

The TEP is the first of its kind in Australia, addressing the unique challenges faced by veteran families. Whether you're a partner looking to return to work, a teenager seeking a part-time job, or someone ready for a career change, the TEP is here to support your journey.

Why Choose The TEP?

Showcase Your Talents: Highlight your unique skills and experience in a centralized profile. Connect with Employers: Access companies actively seeking diverse talent from veteran families.

Privacy Assured: Profiles are designed to protect your identity while allowing employers to view your talents.

It only takes 5 easy steps to create and launch your profile.

Companies that have registered to hire veterans and their families will be able to access your profiles. If a company wishes to connect, you will receive a notification asking for a connection on the areas of employment interests you have listed in your TEP Profile.

For example: ABC construction has asked to connect with you via email. If you decide to connect with ABC Construction, the staff at Working Spirit will receive notifications of companies that have asked to connect with you and you have connected with them. If you do not wish to connect, it is no issue, the team at Working Spirit will receive a notification from you or the company that you have chosen not to connect. This decision will not negatively impact your opportunities.



A Platform Tailored for Military Families


